



# COVID-19 PROTOCOL

**GRAND ISLAND CENTRAL CATHOLIC**

---

*Effective for 2021-2022 school year.*

1. GICC will begin the school year with no mask mandate.
2. GICC will begin the school year at full capacity in all school spaces.
3. The principal shall communicate with a group of physicians on a monthly basis in regard to the nature of COVID-19 in Grand Island.
  - a. This group shall be determined by the principal.
  - b. The meetings shall advise school administration on best practices for student health and wellbeing.
4. Any amendments to the COVID policy will be made by the principal. Changes shall be communicated with the School Board by email as necessary.
5. Students who test positive for COVID-19 will be asked to isolate in accordance with best practices.
  - a. Students who encounter a positive case will not be asked to isolate unless the public health authorities deem it necessary to do so.
6. GICC will cooperate with vaccination efforts of local health entities.
  - a. GICC will allow students to leave school for vaccination without any penalty.
  - b. GICC will not inhibit students nor staff from receiving vaccination.
7. GICC will enact all public health directives set forth by the State of Nebraska.
